Troparion (Tone 8): Thou didst descend from on high, O Merciful One! Thou didst accept the three-day burial to free us from our sufferings! O Lord, our Life and Resurrection: glory to Thee!

Holy Fathers (Tone 8): Most glorious art Thou, O Christ our God! Thou hast established the Holy Fathers as lights on the earth! Through them Thou hast guided us to the true faith! O greatly Compassionate One, glory to Thee!

Kontakion (Tone 8): By rising from the tomb, Thou didst raise the dead and resurrect Adam. Eve exults in Thy Resurrection, and the world celebrates Thy rising from the dead, O Greatly Merciful One.
Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.

Kontakion: (Holy Fathers, Tone 6): The Son who shone forth from the Father was ineffably born, two-fold in nature, of a woman. Having beheld Him, we do not deny the image of His form, but depict it piously and revere it faithfully. Thus, keeping the True Faith, the Church venerates the icon of Christ Incarnate.
Now & ever & unto ages of ages. Amen.

Steadfast Protectress (Tone 6): Steadfast Protectress of Christians, constant advocate before the Creator, despise not the cry of us sinners, but in your goodness come speedily to help us who call on you in faith, hasten to hear our petition and to intercede for us, O Theotokos, for you always protect those who honor you.

Prokeimenon (Tone 8): Pray & make your vows before the Lord our God! Vs. In Judah God is known; His Name is great in Israel!

(For the Fathers): Blessed art Thou, O Lord God of our Fathers & praised & glorified is Thy Name forever!

Epistle: 2 Cor. 6:16-7:1: Brethren, What agreement has the temple of God with idols? For we are the temple of the living God; as God said, "I will live in them & move among them, and I will be their God, and they shall be my people. Therefore come out from them, and be separate from them, says the lord, and touch nothing unclean; and I will welcome you, and I will be a father to you, and you shall be my sons & daughters, says the Almighty." Since we have these promises, beloved, let us cleanse ourselves every defilement of body & spirit, and make holiness perfect in the fear of God.

Alleluia (Tone 8): Come, let us rejoice in the Lord! Let us make a joyful noise to God our Savior. Vs. Let us come before His face with thanksgiving; let us make a joyful noise to Him with songs of praise.

(For the Fathers): The Lord, the God of gods, speaks & summons the earth from the rising of the sun to its setting.

Gospel: Luke 7:11-16: At that time, Jesus went to a city called Nain, and His disciples and a great crowd went with Him. As he drew near to the gate of the city, behold a man who had died was being carried out, the only son of his mother, and she was a widow; and a large crowd from the city was with her. And when the Lord saw her, He had compassion on her, and said to her, "Do not weep." And he came & touched the bier, and the bearers stood still. And he said, "Young man, I say to you, arise." And the dead man sat up, and began to speak. And He gave him to his mother. Fear seized them all; and they glorified God, saying, "A great prophet has arisen among us!" and "God has visited his people!"

(Fathers): Rejoice in the Lord, O ye righteous; praise befits the just. Alleluia, Alleluia, Alleluia.
